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Definitions

- Esoteric: understood or belonging to the select few
 - Greek esterikos: within inner (depth)
 - Teaching or spiritual practice or path or wisdom tradition that is based on a mystical interpretation of spirituality
- Occult: secret; disclosed or communicated only to the initiated
 - Latin occultus: to hide from view

Ancient Mysteries Become Christianity

Augustine (354 – 430):

- "What is called the Christian religion today (400AD) existed already among the ancients and was present with the beginnings of the human race. But when Christ appeared in the flesh the true religion which was already in existence, received the name of Christian"
- Battle of Faith and Knowledge
 - Are you an initiate?
 - Can you become one in this lifetime?
 - How can Christianity be for all the people? Equal?

New Mystical Path Open To All

- Before Christianity, path of
 - Learning for the elect \rightarrow monks
 - Path of mythology for the rest \rightarrow faithful
- After Christ, two similar paths of development
 - 1. The human soul develops within it the forces leading it to the cognition of its true self and eventually to Christ
 - This becomes a Mystery knowledge path enriched through the Christ event
 - Augustine rejected this way as springing from pride of soul
 - 2. By developing forces of the soul as far as possible and then proceed to receive the ideas connected with the Christ event from written accounts and oral traditions
 - Augustine thought the second way was the way of true humility
 - Now it was possible for every soul to experience the spiritual




- Student of both Leonardo and Bergognone

- Leonardo's signature appears 3 times on the back



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



Tertullian describes Pilate as "already a Christian in his conscience"


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INRI: Jesus Nazorite Rex Judeaorum

Greek: Nazoraios Alpha & Omega



John 20:5-6 – The Stone Removed!

- John arrives first
 - Sees (βλεπειν)
 - lying flat on the ground the pieces of linen
- saw and believed: eiden (ειδεν) kai episteusen

- Peter goes in first
 - Beholds (θεωρει)
 - the pieces of linen lying flat on the ground
- went away to themselves
- Mary stoops into the tomb.
- Beholds ($\theta \epsilon \omega \rho \epsilon i$) "two angels in white" shroud
- Reverses her gaze (στρεφω) to behold (θεωρει) Jesus
- Cannot understand her perception until her hierophant calls to awaken her "Mary!" – eiden (ειδεν)



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



What Do I Do?

- Eternal truths in contemporary reflection
 - Our times: take up in full clear waking consciousness, the cosmic truths
